Philip Rodney Perry, born in Saluda, SC, was named to the 2008 South Carolina Dairy Hall Fame at Clemson University. Perry received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Dairy Science from Clemson University in 1975. In 1982 Perry received his Masters Degree in Agriculture from Clemson University.

Perry's work history began in 1975 with the Clemson University Extension Service in Saluda County. From 1978 to 1982 Perry worked with the Dairy Extension Staff at Clemson University.
